PROJECTS WE ARE WORKING ON



2025—Seismic Retrofit of Pump Stations 4, 5 & 6 (High Valley). FEMA funded. Retrofit Pump Stations 7 & 8 (Licorice Ferns), District funded. Update buildings, power, pumps and telemetry.



2025/26—Permanent connection to Renton for use in emergencies. FEMA funded. Emergencies include loss of single connection to Seattle Public Utilities and/or large scale fire fighting.



2025—Drill new well at the District Office. FEMA funded. New location is outside of landslide, flood and liquefaction risk and will provide water to customers after an emergency or loss of our single connection to Seattle Public Utilities.



2027-2030—Build Shop adjacent to existing office buildings to house expensive equipment (Vactor Truck, Back Hoe, Dump Truck) and inventory. Funding to be determined.



2025—Hazard Vulnerability Plan Update with King County. To identify measures the District can take to minimize the impact from disasters.



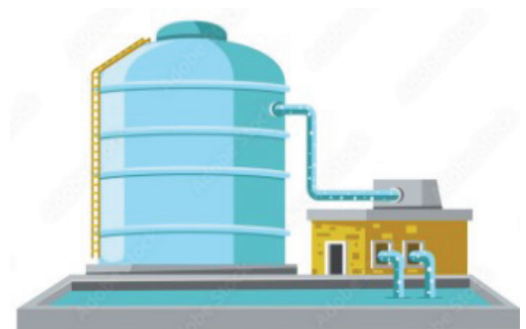
Future—Install 1.6 miles of new water main along May Valley Road from Squak Mountain Rd SE to Issaquah Hobart Road SE. To provide fire flow and water services to future customers experiencing well issues. This area requires annexation into the District service boundaries. Funding tbd.



2025—Solar Planning at new shop and well field locations adjacent to the existing District offices. Department of Commerce Grant funded.



2026—Relocate existing Automatic Meter Reading Tower to center of property. Antenna collects meter data only and does not send out any signals. District funded.



2026—Build Water Treatment Plant adjacent to the District office. FEMA Funded. Treat new well water to ensure safety.
