RESOLUTION NO. 1142

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, providing for an increase and changes in the current water rates and administrative charges charged by the District and adopting a Schedule of Charges.

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners has reviewed and determined that changes to the description and the amount of various charges for residential and commercial rates and administrative charges is necessary to provide sufficient revenues to meet the District's planning, maintenance and financial obligations; and

WHEREAS, a Schedule of Charges has been prepared by District staff setting forth the water rates for residential accounts, government accounts, school accounts, commercial accounts, mobile home park accounts, irrigation rate accounts, and commercial fire sprinkler rates, together with miscellaneous administrative charges as authorized by the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County Water District No. 90, King County, Washington, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the attached Schedule of Charges is adopted entirety as approved by the Board at its regularly scheduled Board of Commissioners meeting on October 15, 2024.

SECTION 2: That the attached Schedule of Charges for rates, charges, and fees of the District effective for the year 2025 and until such time as another Schedule of Charges is adopted, is hereby adopted. Rates which are billed bi-monthly shall become effective for any bills issued after January 1, 2025. For other charges, where no other effective date is designated, the charges are either a continuation, without change, of existing charges; or the new charges shall become effective on January 1, 2025. All charges shall be administered in accordance with the District's

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policy resolutions. To the extent any resolutions establish amounts of charges that are set forth in the attached Schedule of Charges, then the charges set forth in those resolutions are superseded by this Resolution. Otherwise, such other resolutions remain in full force and effect.

The District is also adopting an inspection fee, as set forth in the Schedule of Charges, for new meter installations due to Federal and State requirements that require the District to keep records of materials used for service line installations.

Payment is due in advance of receiving the Water Availability Certificate.

Meter Installation

All fees are collected in advance of Installation. Fees must be paid by cash or check.

Customers must be ready for meter installation within one month of payment.

Bimonthly charges start the day your meter is installed.

Complicated installations require a deposit of \$9,500. Complicated installation are determined in the sole discretion of the District staff and will be charged actual time and materials. See Resolution #1071

Paving plus 20% overhead is charged separately.
